2011 BOULEVARD BOLT FACT SHEET

- WHAT:** 5-mile run/walk (USATF certified course) – The Bolt celebrates its **18th Anniversary** year of raising funds to benefit the homeless on Thanksgiving Day in 2011.
- WHERE:** The course is along Belle Meade Boulevard. Start and finish is at St. George's Episcopal Church.
- WHEN:** Thanksgiving Day morning, **Thursday, November 24, 2011.**
Race Day registration open from 6:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m.
Race begins at 8:00 a.m.
- WHO:** Anyone can participate (any age) in the race.
(No strollers or pets please!)
Approximately 8,500 adults and children registered in 2011.
- COST:** \$30 per person online at www.active.com thru November 15 (online registration closes 11/18)
\$30 per person if postmarked by November 15, 2011
\$40 per person if registered online or in person between November 16-23, 2006
\$60 per person if registering day of race (if not sold out)
